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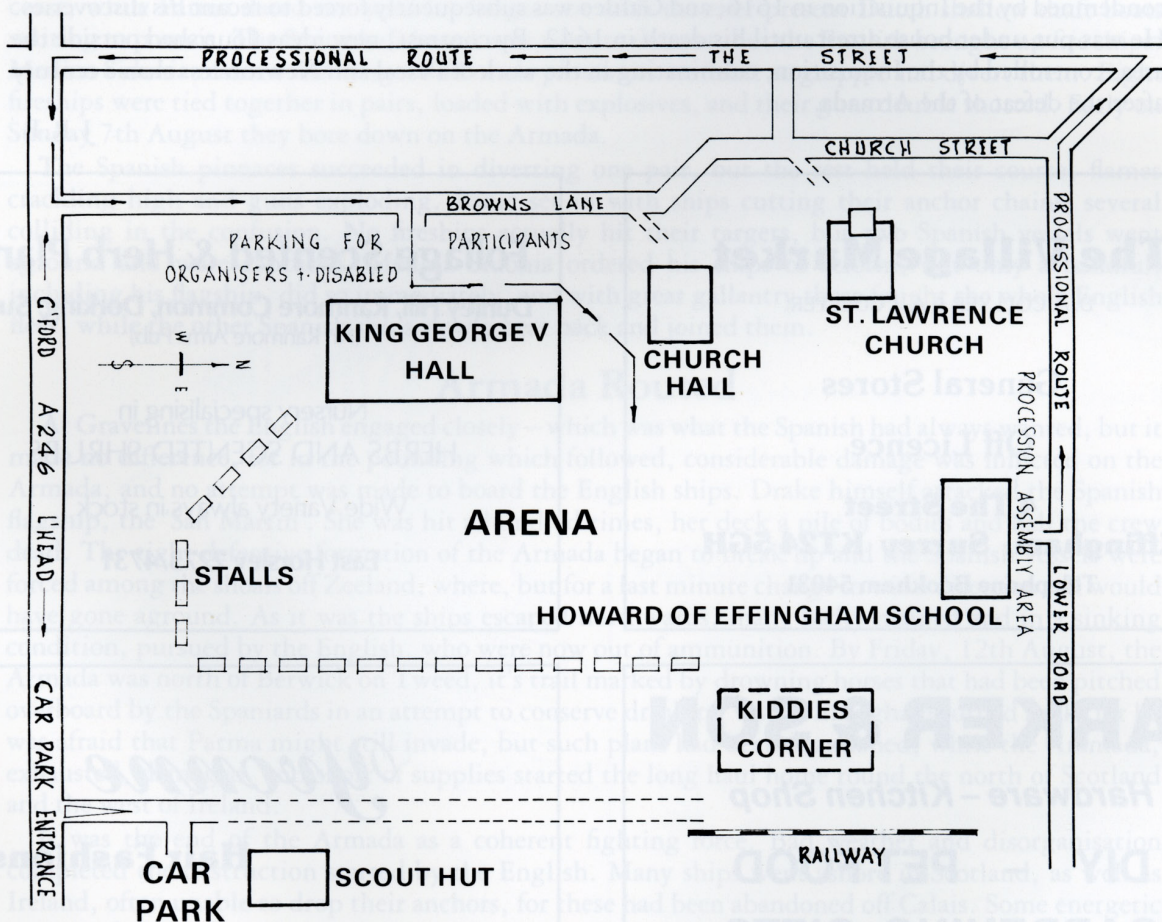

The girls and boys who comprise the RMLI Cadets are aged between 8 and 16 years. They are trained by Instructors, all of whom are either serving or ex-Royal Marines. The training has an emphasis on musical ability, discipline and turn-out hence the motto "PRIDE ALWAYS". The band wears the distinctive uniform of the Royal Marines Light Infantry before 1923.

Since formation, the band has had the honour to play before

Royalty, and the special privilege of playing into Portsmouth Harbour ships of the Royal Navy returning from action in the Falklands. The band has had the honour of performing at the Royal Tournament for three consecutive years. They will lead the procession of floats through the village to the opening ceremony. The band will play during the day and will close the afternoon ceremonies with Beating Retreat and the Last Post.
