### 1. Notes of Last Meeting.

ACTION

The notes of the last meeting were looked through and commented upon accordingly. It was agreed that there would be no theme this year but could be for the Millennium.

The design of posters was discussed and their distribution. Alison Parsons agreed to take it on - pink or green florescent paper with not too much information on it. 30 x A4, 12 x A3 posters to be printed by a Bookham Printer with a banner on the corner. Howard School were unable to help with producing a design.

St Teresa's stakes and boards were offered and they would be covered with individual words/letters to be placed at strategic points along the Lower Road and at the crossroads.

Art Exhibition

The small Scout marquee would be required by the British Legion and the larger one for the Silver Band.

Charges for Charity Stalls

It was decided that we would charge £15 for the stalls for charities, the Red Cross was booked but would not be charged. There were some changes to the list of events - see attached amended list.

Fun Run

Gordon Osborne wondered if he could organise a "Fun Run". It was felt that he could organise it as well as other events on the Sports Courts if possible.

Other events

Bocketts Farm could supply animals but no handlers so it was agreed that we would not pursue this. Alison Parsons would ask the Head Teacher if he wanted the children to do anything else.

Car Parking

James Nicholls would be in charge of car parking and Howard School would be asked for the loan of the Browns Lane field if this was appropriate. St Teresa's Prep School car park could be used as an overflow.

Tables

Tables would be available from the British Legion hall, with St Lawrence Church and St Teresa's Prep with extra ones if needed. Chris Simmonds would be asked if he was prepared to collect but would need assistance with this.

Treasurer/Money collection

Trevor would like some help on the day collecting and counting money. (Chris Boughey has since agreed to assist). GW

The event starts at 12.30pm.

We would be able to use St Lawrence Church's licence for the raffle. Suggestions were made as to the large raffle prize - Saffron Gardens, Cartelodge, Preston Cross, Bookham Grange, Thatchers, The Plough, Sir Douglas Haig and The Grange. Jessica Page would be asked if these could also be approached
