

Woodlands Road – History and Memories – Supplement

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This supplementary article corrects two words in the primary article.

Introduction

The primary article [*Studies in the History of Effingham*, Vol 5, Article 38] discussed the building of new houses in Woodlands Road in the early 1980s so as to close the long-standing gap that had been reserved originally to allow the construction of a feeder road 'Route 37' (which would have passed through that gap) to serve the M25 motorway. The abandonment of the feeder road scheme meant that the gap could now accommodate new houses, which would entail the renumbering of many of the road's existing houses.

This renumbering was discussed in the primary article beneath Figure 14. The text there had a sentence beginning 'The pre-existing plot numbers ...' in which the words 'eastern' and 'western' were the wrong way round. The correct sentence is:

'The pre-existing plot numbers 80, 82, etc on the western side would now each be increased by 12, so becoming 92, 94 etc, whilst the plot numbers 69, 71 etc on the eastern side would now each be increased by 10, so becoming 79, 81 etc.'
